Students must obtain 80 out of the possible 100 points to become a member of NJHS.

Community service and leadership activities may range in date from kindergarten to current grade level. Community service and leadership activities would NOT include courses taken at school, like band, choir, or GTT. However, you may include ways in which you consistently help a teacher or show leadership in the classroom.

Please describe the service activity or leadership role in the table provided. This section of the application is worth 10 points. Two points will be awarded for each hour of service; two points will be awarded for each leadership role.
